## CALL FOR PAPERS

“El pasado depende de nuestra memoria *aquí y ahora*, y el futuro de nuestro deseo, *aquí y ahora*. La memoria y el deseo son nuestra imaginación presente: éste es el horizonte de nuestros constantes descubrimientos y éste es el viaje que debemos renovar cada día” – wrote Carlos Fuentes in his book *La gran novela latinoamericana* (2011).

1492 and 1522 mark two important dates in the history of humanity and, especially, in the history of the Hispanic world. After completing the Reconquest in January 1492, the Catholic Monarchs signed the Alhambra Decree on March 31, according to which the Sephardic Jews were expelled from Spanish territories, causing the exile of between 150,000 and 200,000 Jews. In April, Christopher Columbus and the Catholic Monarchs signed the Capitulations of Santa Fe, which contained the agreements about the planned expedition by sea to the West. On October 12, Christopher Columbus arrived in the New World for the first time and in the same year Fort Navidad, the first Spanish settlement was established in the American continent. Also in 1492, the *Gramática Castellana* of the philologist Antonio de Nebrija was published, the first work dedicated to the study of the Castilian language in history. The Spanish humanist died in 1522. The third letter of relation of Hernán Cortés that details the conquest of Tenochtitlán is dated in 1522 and in the same year the conqueror was named governor, captain general and chief justice of New Spain by Carlos V. Another outstanding event of this year is the completion of the first circumnavigation of the world. A single ship with 18 crew members, under the command of the Spaniard Juan Sebastián Elcano, returned to the port of Sanlúcar on September 6, 1522 without the Portuguese captain, Ferdinand Magellan, who had been killed a year earlier in the Philippine Islands. To commemorate the 500<sup>th</sup> and 530<sup>th</sup> anniversaries of such important events, the
